June 22nd, 2019

Location: Doggone Dirty Dock Diving 756 Jarvis Lane Hollister, CA 95023

Judge: Mark Dias Briefing at 9 AM, 1st jump at 10:00am. Launches will take place at 2 hour intervals: 12:00pm, 2:00pm, and 4:00pm.

Dock will be a regular competition length 40' dock.

4 Launches , 2 jumps/launch. Best of 2 jumps determines placement. Pre-Entry \$100 for all 4 or \$25 per launch. Pre-entries open May 17th 2019 & must be postmarked by June 14th 2019.

Open Dock - \$15 per dog per day. Open dock is for people just wanting to practice/try it. If you have registered that day of competition, you do not need to pay for open dock to get in more practice in between launches.

Awards: Flat ribbons will be awarded for 1st-4th place in each division. 1st place teams will also receive an additional award.

Day of entry , limited to space available: \$30/launch. You can also apply for a QT number with your day of entries. (see link below) Day of entries will remain open all day.

This event will be open to all breeds and mixed breeds. An ASCA Registration #, LEP#, or QT number will be required to track any titles. The application for the tracking number can be found here: <https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/trackapp.pdf>.

****No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA Dock Jumping Program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA. Bitches in season may not compete at this event.****

Turn left onto Rosa Morada. Turn right onto Jarvis and you will see a sign on the right Doggone Dirty Dock Diving.

Note to exhibitors:

** If you are signed up for Launches, during competition there are no practice jumps. If you need to practice or get your dog wet, please be there before the Launch time and we will put exhibitors before open dock dogs. Competitors do not have to pay for open dock practice jumps, and will receive precedence over non-contestants for Open Dock jumps.

****Open Dock** - Dogs not in competition can pay a \$15 per dog practice fee, and you can practice all day in between competition rounds. You'll get in line with everyone else, take 2 jumps, then get back in line. If you're brand new, we can help you get started. When you get to the event, just find the event secretary's tent and ask her if there is availability. You will be asked for your name and signature for the liability waiver, & anyone else

that will be going on the dock with you must do the same. NOTE: You do not have to be a registered competitor to come out and practice, but we highly encourage your dog to be a swimmer and have toy drive.

******Make sure to let the trial chair/check in person know that this is your first time, and please try not to be intimidated... we were all in your shoes at one time or another, and before you know it, you'll know everyone's name

and hopefully you'll be coming to as many events as you can because you and your dog will be hooked!

AGREEMENT

The person who signs this agreement represents that he/she is authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of both exhibitor and the owner of entered dog. In consideration of acceptance of this entry:

- 1.1 As used here, "ASCA" means the Australian Shepherd Club of America, its affiliate clubs and each of their members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees, and agents.
- 1.2 Handler/owner agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of ASCA and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3 Handler/Owner certifies that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs, or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4 Handler/Owner acknowledges all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to: the condition of the floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures (or lack thereof), electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas, and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people. Exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5 Handler/Owner releases ASCA, the ASCA affiliate club (including its officers, directors, members, and event organizing committee), and the site owner(s) harmless from all present and future loss, injury, damage, claims, demands and liabilities involving the entered dog, the event, or event premises. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing hold harmless provisions, handler/owner hereby specifically assume sole responsibility for, and agree to indemnify and save aforementioned parties harmless from, any and all loss and expenses (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damages because of bodily injuries, including death, at any time in consequence of my (our) participation in this event; howsoever such injury, or death, may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused, or may have been alleged to have been caused, by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

ASCA Service Membership and QT Number Application

In order to have ASCA trial points tracked and to receive titling certificates, each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA QT Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the QT number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type, Service, is required). ASCA membership does not have to be maintained in subsequent years.

It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify previous ASCA points earned when applying for a QT Number.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to have a QT number to compete?

- You do not need a QT number in order to compete in Agility, Stock or UAD events, unless you want to earn ASCA titles.
- You will need a QT number to enter an Obedience Trial, Rally Trial, Tracking Test or ASCA Sanctioned Dock Jumping.
- Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a QT number from ASCA.

Why would I need or want a QT number for my dog?

If you would like your dog's points recorded by ASCA, and receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments, you will need to obtain a QT number.

What is the total cost for a QT number?

In order to obtain a QT number for your dog, you must be a member. The cost for a basic Service Membership is **\$10 per owner** if not already a current member.

- Your membership is good for one year and does not need to be renewed unless you want to obtain another QT number for another dog after your membership has expired.

This membership fee is in addition to the QT number fee of **\$10 per dog**.

A QT number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you only have one dog, the total cost would be **\$20**. For two dogs, the cost would be **\$30**, etc.
