

# PASA Mar 27-28 2021 ASCA Trial General Information

## Check-in Schedule (check in only on your first day)

<b>DAILY Check in/measure in:</b>	<b>7:30 – 8:00AM</b>
<b>Briefing:</b>	<b>8:00AM</b>
<b>First walk through:</b>	<b>8:15AM</b>
<b>First Dog on the line:</b>	<b>8:30AM</b>

You must measure in if:

- ✓ You are jumping at 20" or under in Standard (16" in Veterans)
- ✓ If you have a copy of a permanent height card that shows the dog's actual height from another organization, you may present that at check in.

There are 56 dogs entered with a total of 478 runs for the weekend. How can you single-handedly help us finish in time for a long hot shower and leisurely dinner?

- ✓ Check in for each class using Agility Gate App – we will not have paper checkin sheets.
- ✓ If you are NOT within 5 dogs of running, please stay OUT of the congested area between the rings. **Look at Agility Gate!**
- ✓ **If you ARE within 5 dogs of running, go to and STAY IN the congested area between the rings. Look at Agility Gate!**
- ✓ **LISTEN to the gate steward! Look at Agility Gate!**
- ✓ Smile at the score tables. And have fun!

## Off Leash area

Off-leash dog warm up area is in SE corner of lot. Please, only 2-3 people at a time (it's visible from the road).

## Food

No food will be available on site due to COVID restrictions. Please make sure you bring anything you need.

## We're trying to be Green!

Water will be provided but you must bring your own container (we're trying to be more green, so we have cut back on water bottles). And please use the recycle containers.

## Course Maps and Gate

One copy of the course maps will be posted. Copies will be available from <http://www.agilityrecordbook.com/pasa.php> (and possibly from pasadogs.com also) the night before (no earlier than 6p). We will not provide copies.

Check in at the gate will be done using Agility Gate (<https://agilitygate.com/>). You must download this to your phone using Google Play Store or the iPhone Store. The access code will be 6039 (the last part of my cell phone). (The app has a purple background.)

## COVID Information

Masks must be worn at all times, except when running or in your car. (Workers in a location which keeps them away from others are not required to wear masks.) Events such as ours are under great scrutiny. We don't want to be the reason all agility shows get shut down!

## Move-ups

Move ups are permitted. You must sign the move-up list within 15 minutes after the last run is posted on Saturday. If you forget, we *cannot* move you up the following day.

## Directions

From San Jose: Take I-680N to I-580E toward Livermore. Continue about 10 miles: Exit at N Livermore, Avenue. At the end of the off ramp turn left (north). Continue about 2 miles. The property is on the right.

From Tracy: Take I-580W. After descending the Altamont pass, exit at N Livermore Avenue (the fourth exit). At the end of the off ramp turn right (north). Continue about 2 miles. The property is on the right.

## Setup and Crating

The site is outdoors on grass. PLEASE LEAVE AT LEAST 6' BETWEEN ALL SETUPS (unless you reside together).

General setup is not allowed until we have finished setting up all the rings (this begins around 3pm). If you setup before we are done, we will move you! We hope to be done by 4pm on Fri. If you want to help, we'll be done sooner!

## RVs and Parking

RVs may arrive after 6p. Please plan on arriving no later than 9p. (The front gate will be closed between 9:00 pm and 6:00 am — so entry during that period will require prior arrangements.)

The easiest way for RVs to enter would be through the gate at the SW corner of the property. Everyone else could use either that gate or the main gate.

Parking for RVs, cars, etc. is on mowed wild grasses — with limited small patches of bare dirt. The parking area is probably 100-150 feet away from the agility field. There is very little to no shade in the parking area — and somewhat more shade in the setup area. Dogs must be on leashes everywhere on the property when not in the agility ring.
