CLASSES OFFERED and RUN ORDER:

Utility B/A, Open ODX B/A, Open CDX B/A, Novice B/A (group exercise will follow completion of the Novice A individual exercises), Beginner Novice B/A, **Grad Novice, Versatility**

SITE INFORMATION:

The trials will be held at the Anderson residence at 3987 N Livermore Ave, Livermore, CA. The ring will be sited on a grass field. The property will be open on trial day from approximately 7:30 am to 6:00 pm.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

From San Jose: Take I-680N to I-580E toward Livermore. Continue about 10 miles: Exit at N Livermore, Avenue. At the end of the off ramp turn left (north). Continue about 2 miles. The property is on the right.

From Tracy: Take I-580W. After descending the Altamont pass, exit at N Livermore Avenue (the fourth exit). At the end of the off ramp turn right (north). Continue about 2 miles. The property is on the right.

SCHEDULE:

Morning trial: The trial will start at 9:00. Day-of-trial entries for both am and pm trials (if available) will be accepted 8:00-8:45.

Afternoon trial: The trial will start 30 minutes after the completion of the morning trial, but not earlier than 12:00. Day-of-trial entries for the pm trial (if available) will be accepted for up to one hour before the start of the afternoon trial, beginning no earlier than the completion of the morning trial.

AWARDS:

Obedience: 1st-4th ribbons for all classes; Qualifying ribbons for scores of 170 or higher; Rosettes for High in Trial in the regular classes, Highest Combined Score in Open B and Utility and Highest Scoring Junior Handler in the regular classes, High Scoring Aussie.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

All dogs must have an ASCA registration number, a LEP number or a QTracker number to participate in these trials. More information about and an application for a QTracker number is available at <https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/trackapp.pdf>.

No entry will be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from ASCA Obedience or all ASCA programs; nor a person not in good standing with ASCA.

Pre entries must be postmarked by Tuesday March 16, 2021 and received by 6:00 pm Tuesday March 23, 2021.

The entry limit for these trials is a combined total of 50 runs. No pre entries nor day-of-trial entries will be accepted after this entry limit is reached.

Pre entry fees: \$17 per class; \$13 for the second class that a dog is entered in at any one trial. (Note: there are two trials on Friday. This discounted price is only available for dogs entered in two classes in the same trial.)

Day-of-trial entry fees (for entries NOT postmarked/received by the pre entry deadlines): \$20 per class. There is no discount for additional classes. *Please contact the trial secretary to verify day-of-trial availability.*

Entry forms: All ASCA entry forms (including Obedience) were updated on **October 8, 2020**. Only this entry form will be accepted.

No entry fees will be refunded after the entry limit has been reached. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There is a \$40 service charge for returned checks.

24-hour EMERGENCY VETERINARIANS:

Sage Veterinarian Centers Return to I-580; turn west (right) on I-580, in 7 miles exit at
7121 Amador Plaza Rd Dougherty Rd, turn right at the end of the offramp and
Dublin, CA immediately merge into the left lanes; left turn at first light onto
925 574-7243 Dublin Blvd; in about 1 mile pass under the freeway;
then right at the first traffic light onto Amador Plaza Rd;
in about 0.2 miles Sage is on the right, immediately past the REI.

No food will be available on site.

Volunteers are always welcome at ASCA trials. Without such help, we cannot conduct trials. If you're available to help during the trial—even for a short time—or can bring someone who can, please send an eMail to Rick (amoeba@pobox.com) that describes your/their availability.

Please clean up after your dog. Please keep your dog on leash when not competing.

COVID-19 CONSIDERATIONS:

Do not come if you feel sick. Do not come if you have travelled out of the state and not sheltered in place for at least 14 days. Do not come if you have been to any gatherings within 14 days of the trials in which COVID safety protocols have not been observed.

Participants are required to follow state, local and facility guidelines that apply to COVID-19 safety.

Masks are required everywhere on the grounds—except in your car or at your setup. The judge may allow exhibitors to un-mask while they are in the ring: in that case, you **must** re-mask before exiting the ring. You must bring your own mask.

Everyone is encouraged to maintain 6' social distancing. Avoid shaking hands or hugging. Avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility.
