

PASA Mar 31/Apr 1 2012 ASCA Trial General Information

Check-in Schedule (check in only on your first day)

DAILY Check in/measure in:	7:00 – 7:30AM
Briefing:	7:30AM
First walk through:	7:45AM
First Dog on the line:	8:00AM

You must measure in if:

- ✓ You are jumping at 20" or under in Standard (16" in Veterans) [New rules as of Feb 2012]

If you have a copy of a permanent height card that shows the dog's actual height from another organization, you may present that at check in.

There are 78 dogs entered with a total of 652 runs for the weekend. How can you single-handedly help us finish in time for a long hot shower and leisurely dinner?

- ✓ Check in at the gate for each class while you are doing your walkthrough.
- ✓ If you are NOT within 5 dogs of running, please stay OUT of the congested area between the rings.
- ✓ **If you ARE within 5 dogs of running, go to and STAY IN the congested area between the rings.**
- ✓ Smile at the score tables. And have fun!

Silver Buckle Series

This is the second trial in the Silver Buckle Series. It is open to any dog that earns at least one qualifying Regular run in a 2012 PASA sanctioned ASCA trial. See <http://www.pasadogs.com> for more details.

Food

There will be a food vendor on site. PASA will provide a continental style breakfast. Workers will be provided a free lunch, including chips a drink, as long as you are working at least 3 classes, *and* have signed up in advance. (Workers will be provided a voucher to use.)

There will be a potluck dinner on Saturday night (weather permitting!) after all the trials finish. Bring something good (anything!) and enjoy dinner with some friends!

We're trying to be Green!

Water will be provided but you must bring their own container (we're trying to be more green, so we have cut back on water bottles). And please use the recycle containers.

Other Events on the Grounds

Due to the number of events going on, we will try to be flexible (jumps can be easily reset). But once a class is over, we will not hold it if you missed your run.

Scoring, Questions, Problems

We will post the results of your runs at the score table. Please DO check them right away if you have any questions about your run, or if it's a leg of particular importance to you. It's true the score table is a busy place that needs to do its job without unnecessary interruptions; however it is also true that *you* are our reason for being there.

If you have any questions or problems (TP in the portapotties, running order, scoring issue, rules question, etc) or *feedback*, feel free to seek out any of the trial committee or PASA members. Our job is to keep you happy!

Move-ups

Move ups are permitted. You must sign the move-up list within 15 minutes after the last run is posted on Saturday. If you forget, we *cannot* move you up the following day.

ATCHs, and other Big titles

If you think you may earn your ATCH, please let us know in advance so we can be prepared to party!

NQ raffle

Once again, we will have the popular "NQ" raffle. For each round that you do *not* quality in, you will earn one ticket. A drawing is held at the end of each day. All day and other special workers also will receive raffle tickets. Directions to Stanislaus Fairgrounds

From the South or North: Highway 99 North or South towards Turlock CA. Take the Fulkerth Exit and go East. Just before the rail road tracks turn Right on Soderquist Road. Go to West Canal Drive and turn Left. Go to North Broadway and turn Left. This has taken you most of the way around the fairgrounds. You will come in Gate 2.

Parking and unloading

Parking is in Picnic area. See the map below.

Setup and Crating

General setup is not allowed until we have finished setting up all the rings. If you setup before we are done, we will move you! We hope to be done by 4p on Fri. If you want to help, we'll be done sooner!

There is little shade so bring your own or share.

There are wading pools to cool your dog.

RVs

There will be someone to help you find your spot. (Look for a helpful person when you head to the RV area.) RVs will have color coded parking passes. Not all spots have sewer hookups – if you don't get one, you can always dump your tank before leaving on Sunday.

We need everybody's help to keep things running smoothly.
